

EEP Study Abroad University Scholarship





for Graduates of British and IB Schools

The "Study Abroad University Scholarship", offered by EEP, is aimed at supporting up to three outstanding graduating students across our British and IB Stream. This scholarship is designed for those who have been accepted into prestigious universities abroad and demonstrates our commitment to fostering academic excellence and global opportunities. Exceptional students are selected for the award to enhance their educational journey and broaden their horizons.

The "Study Abroad University Scholarship" will be provided for a maximum of 3 students across the platform annually, which will amount to an award of 20% of the tuition fee cost, up to EGP 250,000 / GBP 4,000 per student. The scholarship serves as an additional incentive, motivating students to excel academically and pursue their dreams of studying at top-tier institutions abroad.

BRITISH STREAM ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY:

- An average of not less than A/A* in at least 3 A-Level Exams
- An average of not less than A/A* or 9/8 in at least 8 GCSE/IGCSE Exams
- An exceptional record in extra-curricular activities in the areas of STEAM,
 Debating, Sports, Performing Arts or Visual Arts or the equivalent
- An excellent role model and ambassador for the school in all areas, with concrete examples of taking on leadership opportunities within the school and/or local community
- An average attendance rate of not less than 90% in all IGCSE/A-level courses
- An acceptance letter/ unconditional confirmed placement to be received at a prestigious university. (These universities will usually be defined as one of the top 50 institutions in the Times World University Rankings as published on an annual basis, but EEP reserves the right to offer this award for any notable higher education placement.)

This scholarship is available for students in GEMS TBS, GEMS BISM, GISC, AIA, Hayah International Academy, and Hayah International Academy West.

IB STREAM ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

- Final IB Score of 40 and above
- Demonstrate strong performance in all areas of the IBDP, including the Extended Essay (EE), Theory of Knowledge (TOK) and Creativity, Action, Service (CAS) for the full two years of the program.
- An exceptional record in extracurricular activities in the areas of STEAM, debating, MUN, sports, performing arts, visual arts, or the equivalent.
- An excellent role model and ambassador for the school in all areas, with concrete examples of taking on leadership opportunities within the school and/or local community.
- An acceptance letter/unconditional confirmed placement to be received at a
 prestigious university. (These universities will usually be defined as one of the
 top 50 institutions in the Times World University Rankings as published on
 an annual basis, but EEP reserves the right to offer this award for any notable
 higher education placement.)
- Applicants must pass an interview with the school's Diploma Programme Committee to assess their qualifications, potential, and alignment with the scholarship's objectives.
- Applicants must submit a compelling personal statement highlighting unique academic and personal experiences, while articulating how the scholarship will support their academic and personal aspirations.

An unconditional confirmed placement at one of the world's most competitive universities and a confirmation of attendance.
